That is what the leaders of the district 79 portrayed by putting their souls, efforts and time for others. Some of the Divisions have excelled in their performance and while others still strive to achieve more. Today we celebrate the milestones achieved during the mid-year, as a district, as one family.</p> <p>Before starting the meeting, few official businesses should be conducted:</p> <p>Quorum of the meeting: The Administration Manager - TM Rizan, confirmed that there are 78 members of the District Executive Committee. District Director Clarified it. Saying that it was also discussed at Region level. The email states that all four nominations, the nomination should be called before 15th of January 2021 but the date to receive the nominates was set by DLC Chair. Followed the protocols and called for nominations before 15th of January 2021. It was discussed with Region 11 Advisor DTM James Turac, and it was assured that all rules and guidelines was followed.

4. District Recognition

Expect to begin District 79 Recognition Road Trip on Friday March 2nd 2021. It will depend on the current situation of the pandemic in the Kingdom. If there is a lockdown, it will have to be postponed. It won't be 1-day event, it will be a period of 1 month. District Leaders will be traveling around the District recognizing leaders. It not going to be a gathering or have a recognition ceremony, instead a place will be prescribed and awardees can come and collect their award. A schedule will be setup and will announce which recipient should come and on what time. Special thanks to DTM Palaniraj who is handling all shipment and logistics.

Concerned was raised by DTM Samer Kamal. Suggesting that it is better if we say that District Leaders Recognition 2020, instead of breaking it down to PQD 2020 and CGD 2020 Recognition.

District Director totally agrees. It was because since the round table has not finalized the list of recipients.

TM Ali Alsuwaili, also raised a concern. He requested that to find an alternative way, if the pandemic situation does not improve. Maybe recognize through social media or send the awards to the recipients' that also club can give ribbons to the members.

District Director, replied that in the next round table meeting, this topic will be discussed. To have a plan B, however since District 79 is wide spread, they might have to think about the cost they will incur if they ship the awards and whether TMI will allow to include it in the budget.

5. Audit Committee

The District 3-member Audit Committee was appointed on Oct.30th 2020. The Mid-year Audit is now being conducted by the Finance Manager and Audit Chair.

6. Financial Support for Area Contest

Toastmasters International restricted Districts from directly supporting Area Contest in terms of providing with trophies. Since all Area Contest will be held virtually, the District Hands are tied up. Currently, the District is analyzing certain requests made by Division Directors, on how to support the Area's in

any means. Discussions are taking place with Toastmasters International and will update on 12th February 2021.

Area 66 Director – TM Salman Noor, raised a concern. Every year, District is providing financial support, it also very hard to get sponsorship as well. February 12th 2021 is Area 66 Contest. Should the Area Directors spend on the trophies from there pockets and what is the support we can get from the District? Every year at the area contest, winners are awarded trophies, it would be quite right if they don't give this year.

District Director acknowledged the concern. Multiple meetings were held regarding this topic. The rules and regulations must be followed of Toastmasters International. However, arriving at this point of time, there are few items were allocated with money but haven't been utilized. That discussion is discussed with Toastmasters International whether there is a privileged to relocate the money for something fruitful. Hopefully Toastmasters International will agree and it is recommended in general to recognize virtually Once the decision is approved, the required action can be taken.

Division J Director DTM Sankaranunni added that they are, happy to hear the news and hoping to get a positive answer on 12th February 2021.

District Director thanked, and said at time we have to follow the policies, but at the same time members concerns do matter to. Members are above all of use. Thank the PQD for initiative and was so adamant.

7.Club Growth Incentives

District 79 members was informed early through Toastmasters International regarding the new club growth incentives. Effective Immediately any new clubs formed now through June 30,2021, will have the charter fee and new member fee waived. A new club must complete the charter process, pay \$45 USD membership dues for each charter member and pay the prorated amount for the next renewal cycle by June 30th 2021. This incentive is also applicable to prospective club as well, who have already submitted the charter fee. If the club complete the process of organizing their club before June 30th 2021, the charter fee will be refunded.

If there is no strong growth, the realignment of District will not be that healthy, might lose Divisions and might be merging. Requested all Division Directors to take a serious note on that and support and encourage for club growth.

Division F Director Shekar Thiwari, raised a concern. Requested to highlight this announcement and will this announcement change?

District Director, replied that this announcement is all about educating the leaders about this new incentive. If there are any changes, the District 79 CGD will notify the leaders of the District.

Area 07 Director TM Heba AlMohsin the concern was that there are some area which have low number of clubs, we would like to help them. After discussion with the club president. Club Presidents have asked whether they can get help in getting new members.

District Director explained that a District ExCom can not help at any club renewals, according to Toastmasters International Policy. In terms of helping to pay the membership dues or given discount when paying the membership dues is totally out of the question. Toastmasters International has not promoted this idea. However, as District Director, a movement was initiated and a petition has been made to get some benefit when approaching new members. The movement is going on, but not sure whether a positive answer will be achieved. A Division can support a club in many ways, but not in terms of paying membership dues. The Division can analyze the situation with Area Director and find sources to help members. Approach the Club Growth Team for assistance and support.

Area 07 Director TM Heba AlMohsin added that a club president asked why doesn't TMI increase the membership dues, from her. And she stated that TMI has already waived membership dues for the new members. For the old members, the amount isn't so much so why do they have to. The Club President still responded by saying that TMI is not providing much support.

District Director commented that the members might have perception that Toastmasters International is not rendering support. That why as Division and Area Directors, until we come out of these tough times, have to promote that there are ways to benefit.

Area 67 Director Joseph , expressed an idea. In toastmasters we are made to leaders and as leaders, we need to encounter and solve problem in our way. Formulate ways to help your membership drive.

District Director acknowledges and said that leaders must know how to formulate plans and work together to success. Guiding clubs to find ways to increase membership.

A motion was proposed to extend the meeting by 10 minutes.

The motion was carried and adopted. No objections were raised. The meeting was extended.

8. April Renewals

The renewals are now opened, clubs are encouraged to pay. The first club to complete renewals is Taj Toastmasters Club, Division B. Once the club pay the renewals, the official status will be granted.

Area 66 TM Salman Noor has raised a concern, one of the clubs has base of 20 members when chartering the club and now they have paid for 8 members. For the next renewal is it ok to pay for 8 members?

District Director stated that club which started with 20 members as base at the being of the year will have to maintain thought out the year with 20 members as base if it needs to achieve Distinguished Status. Distinguished Status is measured at the end of this year. However, for Division and Area to maintain a base of 8 members are enough.

9. District Conference
